How to get there

Train – can be more convenient / reliable than flying if you have access to a high speed train, e.g. Eurostar from London. Total journey time to 1 rue d'Astorg is around 30 minutes from Paris Gare du Nord via the Metro (take line 4 from Gare du Nord to Strasbourg-Saint-Denis, then line 9 to Saint-Augustin), which includes 5 minutes walking. The cost of a Metro ticket is less than €2.

Airports – Charles de Gaulle is around 25km from the centre of Paris with a good rail link (RER B (blue)) from terminals 2 and 3; if you arrive at terminal 1 there is a free shuttle bus to terminal 3. The train cost is around €10 (one way) and the journey should take around 35 minutes to Châtelet les Halles where you can take line 14 to Madeleine (10 minutes) and walk to 1 rue d'Astorg (5 minutes). Taxis are readily available and cost around €50 - €70 depending on traffic and can take over an hour.

Orly is around 13km from the centre of Paris and is again linked by metro. Line 14 goes directly from Orly airport to Madeleine and vice a versa. The cost is around €10 and the journey should take around 30 minutes in total. From Madeleine you can walk to 1 rue d'Astorg (8 minutes). Taxis are readily available and cost around €45 - €60 and should take around 50 minutes, depending on traffic.

Nearest metro stations – Saint-Augustin (line 9), Miromesnil (lines 9, 13) and Madeleine (lines 8, 12, 14). An interactive metro map is available here: <https://www.ratp.fr/en/plan-metro>
